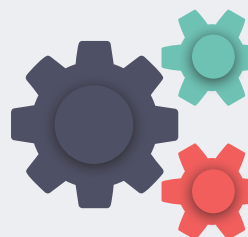
1 Analyze your current SharePoint configuration and content

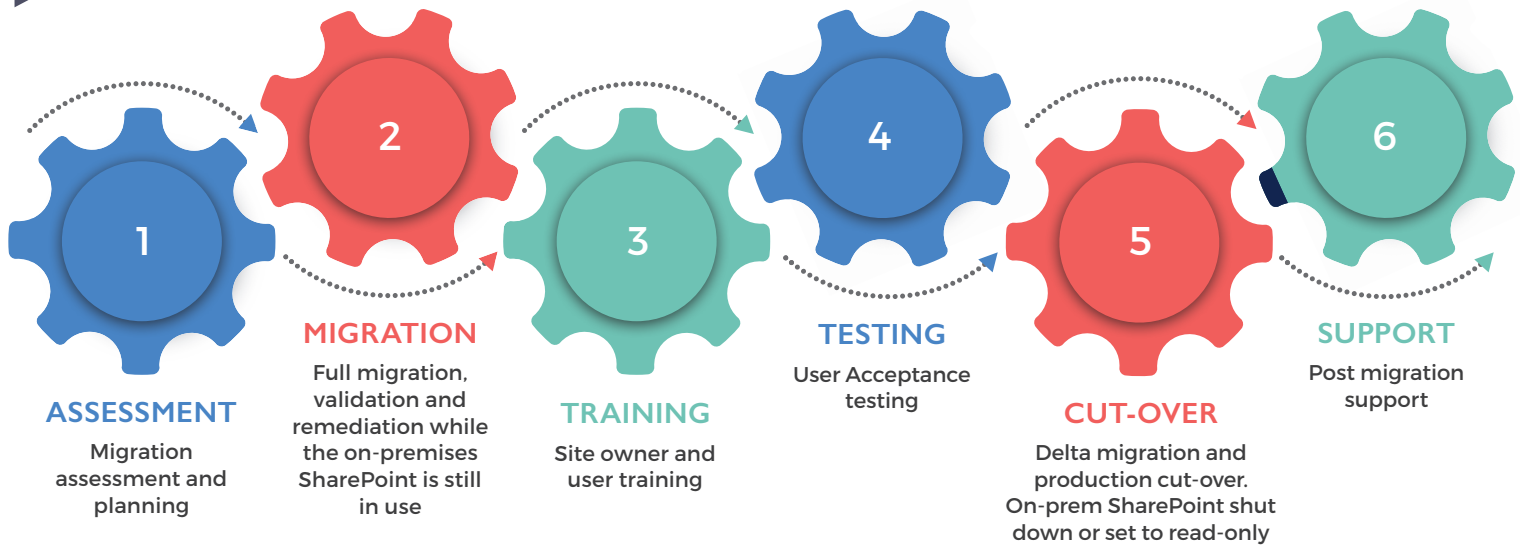

SharePoint Server 2019 Upgrades

The many reasons organizations continue to keep their SharePoint on-premises range from legal and compliance issues to the complexity of the solution. SharePoint Server 2019 offers many of the exciting features that have been rolled out to SharePoint Online users over the past 2 years, providing more of an incentive to upgrade to SharePoint 2019 or a hybrid scenario along with SharePoint Online.

OUR PROCESS

- 1** Migration assessment and planning
- 2** SharePoint 2019 installation and configuration
- 3** Site collection migration using one of the following methods:
 - ▶ Content database upgrade: quick and clean, existing sites maintain classic experience
 - ▶ Rebuild and migrate sites with a tool: more time-intensive, but site collections can be consolidated, deconstructed or converted to the modern experience
- 4** Site owner and user training
- 5** User acceptance testing
- 6** Delta migration and production cut-over. Older SharePoint farm shut down or set to read-only
- 7** Post migration support
