As SharePoint passes its 22nd birthday, Microsoft is embarking on the next chapter for SharePoint Online with a refreshed UX and innovations that will make it simpler for customers to build compelling and engaging sites and pages. While AI took center stage at the Microsoft 365 Collaboration Conference in May 2023, many long-term SharePoint users were elated to see the investment and commitment from Microsoft to expand capabilities in its widely used content services product.

In the next few months, throughout the rest of the year and into early 2024, expect to see a number of changes roll out to enable simpler authoring, create better looking sites, pages and videos, new integration into Teams, Viva and email and the ability to tailor sites to specific workflows and applications via SPFx and API's, all designed to enable business users to do more, in a self-service model as opposed to waiting for an overloaded IT department to accomplish.

- New SharePoint start experience designed to inspire
- New editing capabilities available in the Image Webpart

Fall/Winter 2023/2024:

- Content Pane for SharePoint Pages and News
- New Brand Center
- CoPilot in SharePoint help you create engaging web content
- Resource specific consent capabilities
- Designer for SharePoint Pages
- Co-Authoring for SharePoint Pages

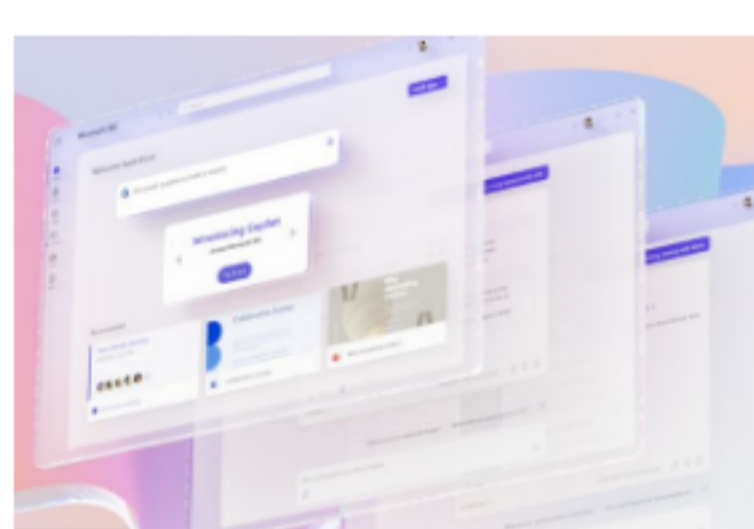
