9. October 14, 2025: End of Extended Support for Office 2016 & Office 2019
10. July 14, 2026: End of Extended Support for SharePoint Server 2016 and SharePoint Server 2019
11. July 14, 2026: End of Extended Support for InfoPath 2013 Client and InfoPath Forms Services Retired in Microsoft 365 SharePoint
