 - Design ideas will help stimulate your creativity by providing design suggestions based on your content or content requirements.
 - Flexible sections expand your design area from 3 columns to all 12 on the SharePoint canvas.
- Autofill is enhanced with AI allowing you to extract key details from documents and automatically organize metadata using natural language prompts. To increase accessibility, Microsoft has lowered the SharePoint Autofill price to \$0.005 per page starting March 2025.


